

Arabic Studies Interdisciplinary Minor (IAIQ)

21 Credits

- Students must satisfactorily complete the total credits required for the minor. Minors and interdisciplinary minors require 12 or more upper-division (300- to 400-level) credits.
- Additional coursework may be required due to prerequisites.
- A grade of C or better is required in each course that will count toward the interdisciplinary minor.
