

## **Chinese Minor (LCHQ)**

## 21 Credits

- Students must satisfactorily complete the total credits required for the minor. Minors and interdisciplinary minors require 12 or more upper-division (300- to 400-level) credits.
- Additional coursework may be required due to prerequisites.
- All majors and minors in the department must earn a minimum grade of C (a grade of C- is not acceptable) in each upperdivision course that carries the LCHI subject code. Courses taught in English may not be used to meet the requirements for the minor.
